Contexto General:

Presente simnple

- Utilizamos el presente simple en inglés para referirnos a hábitos y rutinas. Cosas que hacemos todos los días o a cada semana.
- I go to school at 7.30
- I study everyday
- She always does the homework
- The train arrives at 8.00
- La forma negativa del presente simple es don't/doesn't

I, you, we, they: don't He, she it: doesn't

- I don't do the homework
- She doesn't do the homework
- Recuerda que cuando utilizamos presente simple, con los sujetos He, She, it, el verbo adquiere s, es o jes.
- She likes
- He studies
- It arrives

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- La forma interrogativa del presenta simple se forma con los auxiliares do/does
- Do you speak English?
- Does he speak English?
- Does she speak English?

Presente continuo

- Utilizamos el presente continuo para referirnos a situaciones que ocurren en el mismo momento en que las hacemos o vemos.
- I am going to school now
- He is studying in this moment
- She is doing the homework now
- Look the train is arriving
- La forma negativa del presente continuo se forma con el verbo to be:
- I am not doing the homework
- She isn't doing the homework
- They aren't doing the homework
- La forma interrogativa del presente continuo también se forma utilizando el verbo to be
- Is she doing exercises?
- Are they working?
- Is he studying?
