## Opening and explanations

In order to: We use to introduce a topic, explanation or purpose.

"In order to understand this problem, you have to consider the serious statistics of crime in our towm..."

In other words: To give more information or other explanation about the topic.

"Frogs are amphibian. In other words, they live in land and water..."

That is to say: To explain a point or information

"Whales are mammals, that is to say, they must breathe air..."

# Adding information

Moreover: You give ideas to support your speech

"Moreover, statistics show a high poverty in the district..."

For instance: You give reasons and supporting ideas

"Pollution has increased in the main cities all over the world. For instance, Madrid, New York, Santiago..."

To give an illustration: To show important facts about your speech.

"To give an illustration, we can see the following graphics... "

All things considered: To summarize final ideas.

"All things considered, it is very important to start a project to reduce pollution in our city..."

"To draw a conclusion, we can say that..."

Others: In conclusion, as result, finally, to sum up, in brief, on the whole
