Los primeros conectores que estudiaremos son los conectores de contraste:

#### Although/despite/however

- After **although** we use a **subject + verb**:  
Although it rained a lot, they had a good time  
I didn't apply for the job although I had the necessary qualifications  
We went out although it was raining heavily
- After **despite**, we use a **noun**, a **pronoun** (**this/that/what** etc.) or **-ing**:  
Despite of the rain, we had a good time.  
She wasn't well, but despite of this she continued working  
Despite the fact of the rain, we played the match
- **However** always goes at the **beginning of the sentence** and **before a comma**.  
It was very dark. **However**, I still continued walking  
This is one solution for this problema. **However**, there are others  
Finally we went to France. However, I wanted to visit Portugal

15. \_\_\_\_\_ the restaurant has a good reputation, the food was terrible.
