Los primeros conectores que estudiaremos son los conectores de contraste:

Although/despite/however

- After although we use a subject + verb:
 Although it rained a lot, they had a good time
 I didn't apply for the job although I had the necessary qualifications
 We went out although it was raining heavily
- After despite, we use a noun, a pronoun (this/that/what etc.) or -ing:
 <u>Despite of</u> the rain, we had a good time.
 She wasn't well, but <u>despite of</u> this she continued working
 <u>Despite the fact</u> of the rain, we played the match
- <u>However</u> always goes at the <u>beginning</u> of the sentence and <u>before</u> a comma.
 It was very dark. <u>However</u>, I still continued walking
 This is one solution for this problema. <u>However</u>, there are others
 Finally we went to France. <u>However</u>, I wanted to visit Portugal
